

The Heart of the Project: Gantt Exchange Diagram

The Classical Gantt Diagram visualises work packages as bars and puts them in temporal or logical order. By Gantt chart techniques, risks of project design, critical paths and future bottle necks can be found, measures can be taken proactively.

The "Gantt Exchange Diagram" interpretes the exchange duration patterns as bars of seconded staff from the point of view of host and home organisation alike. Adding the time line enables to calculate bottle necks in the host organisations and to avoid jams or gaps in the overall exchange pattern, thus contributing to a steady project performance. Colours show the institutions and their staff. Totals in hosting and seconding months are directly allocated to the institutions and individual researchers.

From the Gantt Exchange Diagram, financial contributions to the individual researchers can be calculated at one glance, adaptions in exchange pattern can be made very quickly.
