

How many Project Management tools do we really need?

ChangeHabitats 2:- Network for Habitat Modelling and Monitoring by Airborne-supported Field work – an innovative and effective process in implementation of the Habitat Directive. – January 1st 2011 – December 31st 2014

Objectives: ChangeHabitats 2 is the intersectoral and international network between industry and academia in the field of environmental monitoring. It will develop operable, time and cost effective procedures, and (software) solutions for monitoring habitats using innovative airborne data acquisition techniques. Two **complementary data acquisition methods**, currently becoming established in the market, are used: airborne laser scanning and airborne hyperspectral imagery. Both methods will be evaluated for potential manual and automatic derivation of habitat parameters — an unsolved problem so far.

Minimum Management Tools required at Project start:

- Gantt Exchange Diagram, Table- Who-is-Who-in-the-Teams, Task & Allocation Table with Excel warning and controlling devices
- Milestone-Trend-Analysis (MTA), Cash Flow Plan allocated from Grant Agreement and EU Documents, List of Rules,
- Meeting Minutes, Contracts, Time Sheets, Web-based Communication Server
